Additional Data: Gross Scruggs bought the land from James Vaulx in 1812, 320 acres for \$1.280. Later he added 625 acres, making the estate or plantation cover 945 acres.

Gustavis L. Mastin bought the property, house and 945 acres of land on January 9, 1857. Still owned by Mastins descendants.

The building stood in a grove of trees, with woods extending up to within a few hundreds yards of its rear door. A large lawn was laid out on all sides and stretched back towards the woods some 300 yards to the gate of his stable yard, where were kept scores of horses.

Today all is in ruins. The beautiful lawn has distapeared, the trees have been cut down, the negro tenants have plowed the yard up nearly to the back steps of thehouse. Corn, weeds and bushes surround the once lowely home, all traces of its former glory have departed.
