


Frank James was tried and acquitted for stealing a federal payroll in Muscle Shoals. The trial was held at the Calhoun House (corner of Eustis and Greene).

#### CALHOUN HOUSE

On this site stood the Calhoun House, used as a Federal Courthouse, where desperado Frank James was tried and found not guilty. by jury trial, on April 25, 1884, for robbery of a government payroll near Muscle Shoals. Alabama, March II, 1881. One of his defense attorneys was Huntsville's LeRoy Pope Walker, first secretary of war of the Confederate States of America.






### Major General H. N. Toftoy


