The Bell Factory Historical Marker was first placed by Judge David Campbell Chapter 27 October 1957. The chapter has refurbished the marker as shown above and relocated it next to the "bell" at Riverton Elementary School. The Bell Factory derived its name from the large bell used to signal the beginning and end of work periods. Riverton School received the bell in 1918 to be "used to commemorate special occasions highlighting the community activities." The bell is still in use by the community today.


