Nina was daughter of Dell Allen of Georgia, and Thelma (Biggs) Allen from Kansas. Nina died Nov. 11, 1933, after an illness of four years. She is buried in Maple Hill Cemetery. Other children of Clarence and Nina were Ila, Irma, Elsie and Clarence Dell Baker.

No proof that this child is daughter of Clarence and Nina Baker.

The family moved to Madison Co., Alabama before 1864, when their fifth child was born in Alabama. A Sam Baker died of pneumonia on Nov. 14, 1881,
