In 1900, the family was still in Franklin Co. with children: William C., Roxie, Warren, their son, and Bettie his wife, with one grandson, Buford, child of Warren and Bettie. In 1920, John and Margaret lived with their son Warren A. and his wife Bettie in Merrimack, Madison Co., Alabama.

John Gault, born Mar. 9, 1852, died May 23, 1923, and is buried in Fleasant Ridge Cemetery, Huntland, Franklin Co., Tennessee.
