Tommie was a daughter of Henry T. and Tommie (Young) East. Henry and Tommie East had three children, Tommie Lee, Mattie B. and Fearlie.

Tommie and Roy divorced and she married Eunice Jackson. Henry T. Jackson is the only child of the marriage.

Tommie married a third time to Silas Cowart and had two children: Danny and Edna.

Many of the family moved to South Carolina during strikes at Merrimack Mfg. Co.
