Rudy and Frances had four children: Nettie, Emma, George and Annis. Nettie married Ed Seals, Mar. 23, 1910, Emma married Ernest Winkles, Oct. 23, 1909, George married Alma Buford Dec. 22, 1920, and Annis married Thomas L. Baker February 19, 1920.

Charles Meeks was son of Houston and Daisy (Newby) Meeks. Daisy Newby was daughter of Charles and Lula (Weaver) Newby who are both buried in Merrimack Cemetery.

Charles was employed in a textile manufacturing company at the time of their marriage. His home was on 7th St, Huntsville. The home of Zelma was on 11th St., Huntsville.

In 1920, the family was in Florence, Lauderdale Co., Alabama. Later the family moved to Russellville, Alabama, where William H. and Fanny A. Melson died.
