Louie was born Sept. 3, 1912, in New Hope, Madison Co., Alabama. After Mary Annie's death Louie married and moved to Chattanooga, Tennessee. There he was inducted into the U.S. Army in April, 1945. When he was discharged, July 1945, his family lived in Huntsville.
