Tom Ray married Ella Clark, June 30, 1912. Both parties were age 21 at the time. Tom and Ella had three children; Mary, Mamie and Violet. Ella died in an accident near Decatur on Mar. 14, 1938. Daughter Mary, wife of Louie Rice died later of injuries received in the accident. Both Ella and Mary are buried in Merrimack Cemetery.

Mattie Byser married John Russell, son of Amanda Russell who is buried in Merrimack Cemetery. John and Mattie Russell were parents of Nellie Russell who married Clarence McAnelly. Their newborn baby, Betty Joan McAnelly, died and is buried in Merrimack Cemetery.
