Hill, Rev. James, March 19, 1861-Jan. 27, 1937. Faces west.
Hill, Mary, Dec. 8, 1858-Sep. 4, 1931. "Gone but not forgotten."
Faces west.

Driveway

Church, Howard, Jan. 8, 1920-Jan. 14, 1920. "Our loved one."
Faces east. Grave enclosed in Berryhill plot.

Baley, Wilson R., Died March 17, 1925, Age 76. "FATHER" on top
of stone. "Gone to rest." Faces west.

Brown, Maudie Crain, Jan. 12, 1890-Dec. 19, 1912. Stone off
base. Faces east.

(About 12 ft. with no stones from Brown to Cantrell stone.)

Cantrell, James, Feb. 13, 1905-Mar. 20, 1907. Stone in pieces.
Many pieces are missing, 1997.

(About 6 ft. with no stones from Cantrell to Melton stone.)

Melton, Bobbie Lee, Aug. 6, 1891-Apr. 15, 1907. Dau. of John &
Elizabeth Melton. Off base, faces east.

(About 15 ft. with no stone from Melton to long cement block.)

N.A.C. on small marble footstone with no tombstone set in cement
base with Jennie Certain stone. Lettering on west side of
stone. Footstone broken off, 1997.

Certain, Jennie, June 25, 1903-Jan. 4, 1907. Stone broken from
base and in two pieces.

ROW 15.

No stones south of driveway.

North of Driveway.

Burks, Fannie Sherrill, Nov. 20, 1872-Aug. 24, 1924, Wife of
J. M. Burks. "In memory of our beloved mother."
Faces east. Off its base, 1997.

Burks, J. M., Feb. 11, 1865-Sept. 4, 1921. "Gone but not
forgotten" on top of stone. Below dates is "In memory of our
beloved father." Faces east.

Cook, Flossie, Feb. 4, 1907-July 29, 1908. Stone broken from base
and broken in two pieces. Headstone on footstone, 1997.

Crick, Hildry, 1897-1907. Faces west.

ROW 16.

(About 14 ft. from fence with no stones.)

Henson, Mollie Lee, May 9, 1878-Dec. 16, 1935. "Forever with
the Lord." Faces west.

(About 26 ft. without stones from Henson to Ward stone.)

Ward, Ethel Earline, July 21, 1931-Aug. 15, 1931. "Our darling
gone so soon." Faces west.

(About 18 ft. without stones from Ward to Bolin stone.)

Bolin, William, Feb. 20, 1856-Aug. 11, 1931. "He has gone to the
mansions of rest." Faces west.

Ferrell, Roy E., Oct. 4, 1929-Aug. 11, 1931. "Gone but not
forgotten." Faces west.

Driveway

ROW 17.

(About 14 ft. with no stones from fence to Call stone.)

Call, Elizabeth, Sept. 1, 1930-Nov. 14, 1930, "Not my will but
thine be done" Stone broken in three pieces. Lays flat.

(About 18 ft. with no stones from Call to Elmore stone.)

Elmore, Ara, Dec. 26, 1928-Aug. 11, 1930, "Weep not for me, Mama
and Papa, in Heaven with Jesus waiting for you." Faces west.
