 Evans, Charles L., Jr., 1929-1930. "In heaven there is two angels
 more." Faces west.

Elrod, Barbara E., 1903-1939. "At rest." Flat stone faces west.

Elrod, C. W., Aug. 31, 1929-Dec. 21, 1929, Son of Mr. & Mrs. C.
 W. Elrod. "Gone to be an angel." Faces west.
 (About 12 ft. with no stones from Elrod to Cantrell family plot,
 a 15x8 ft. area enclosed with concrete bars.)

Cantrell, S. B., 1850-1933. Concrete marker. Faces west.

Cantrell, Mary, Feb. 14, 1846-May 7, 1928. Wife of Sam'l
 Cantrell. "Gone but not forgotten." Faces west.

Driveway

Harris, George W., Oct. 13, 1866-April 17, 1921. "Asleep in
 Jesus." Faces west.
 (About 22 ft. with no stones to Ransom family plot outlined with
 cement bars.)

Ransom, Martha, Apr. 7, 1855-Apr. 3, 1928. "Safe in the arms of
 Jesus." Faces west.

Ransom, H. L., Apr. 24, 1854-June 10, 1917. "A present one from
 us has gone, and a gentle voice is still, there is a vacant
 place in our home that never can be filled." Faces west.
 (About 31 ft. with no stones to John Crick's stone)

Crick, John A., 1867-1918. Faces west.

(About 14 ft. with no stones from fence to Kelley stone.)

Kelley, Charles W., Oct. 12, 1868-Aug. 25, 1936. Faces west.

Holland, Gary had two stones.
 Gary Holland, 1934-1935. Concrete marker, missing, 1997.
 Son of Mr. & Mrs. Alonzo Holland, Gary O. Holland, Nov. 15,
 1934-Feb. 23, 1937. Faces west. Holland on back of stone.
 (About 5 ft with no stones from Holland to Griffin stone.)

Griffin, Doyle R., Feb. 18, 1929-June 30, 1930, son of Mr. & Mrs.
 T. G. Griffin. "He was the sunshine of our home." Faces west.

Griffin, Grover, 1896-1945. Double stone with Lawrence Griffin.

Griffin, Lawrence, 1916-1945. Flat stone. Faces west.
 (About 8 ft. with no stones from Griffin to Mahaffey stone.)

Mahaffey, Will, 1861-1936. Double stone with Mary Mahaffey.

Mahaffey, Mary, 1865-1930. Flat stone, faces east.
 (About 17 ft. with no stones from Mahaffey to Boyanton stone.)

Boyanton, Shelton Everet, Sept. 6, 1927-Oct. 7, 1928. "A fairer
 bud of paradise never bloomed." Faces west.
 (About 14 ft. with no stones from Boyanton to Preston stone.)

Preston, Beatrice, May 11, 1920-June 13, 1927. Dau. of Mr. & Mrs.
 L. R. Preston. Faces east. "Weep not, father and mother,
 for me for I am waiting in glory for thee" facing west.

Driveway

Crews, Lizzie, Oct. 13, 1873-June 25, 1935. "Our mother." Faces
 west.

Crews, Burley, Apr. 11, 1908-Oct. 24, 1929. "Christ loved him and
 took him home. Faces west.

Story, W. H. Jan. 30, 1921-Jan. 30, 1921. Faces west.
