 "Beloved one farewell, weep not she is at rest." faces west.

Warren, Tom H., died Aug. 16, 1916, age 28 yrs. "Weep not he is at rest." Faces west.

(About 14 ft. with no stones from Warren to Smith stone.)

Smith, Bessie M., died Jan. 1, 1910, aged 25 Yrs. Wife of H. M. Smith. "One we loved sleepeth here." Faces west.

Duke, Mamie, Mar. 18, 1889-Mar. 10, 1910. Wife of Dan Duke. "Gone but not forgotten." Off base. Faces west.

Brown, Susie. June 5, 1908-June 23, 1910, dau. of Alf & Bessie Brown. "At rest." Faces west.

Brown, infant, born and died May 2, 1910. dau. of Alf and Bessie Brown. Broken into small pieces, 1997.

Thomptson, Dollie, 1909-1910, "Our darling." Faces west. Stone was in good shape until 1996 when it was hit by another stone and broken into many pieces. Faces west.

Hays, Josie E., 1893-1940. "Mother."

Adkins, Robert Lee, Feb. 6, 1930-Apr. 11, 1932. "Gone so soon." Faces west.

Parker, Virginia. No dates, flat in ground. Reads from west.

Hays, Lula Marie, 1913-1929. "A little flower of love that blossomed but to die, transplanted now above, to bloom with God on high." Faces west. Stone off base, July 1997.

Walker, John S., Nov. 11, 1889-Sept. 30, 1930. Flat on ground. Reads from east.

Newby, Henry E., 1861-1929. Faces west.

Fendergraft, J. T., Jr. Apr. 14, 1928-Jan. 9, 1929. Son of Mr. & Mrs. J. T. Fendergraft. "Our darling baby is at rest." Faces west.

Allen, Evelyn Maxine, Nov. 22, 1926-Nov. 11, 1927. "Budded on earth to bloom in Heaven." Faces west.

Driveway
 (About 56 ft. with no stones from drive to Dobbs.)

Dobbs, Sammie, Sept. 6, 1889-Aug. 6, 1910. "Gone but not forgotten." Faces west.

ROW 22.

(About 46 ft. with no stones from fence to Whitt stone.)

Whitt, Raymond L., Jan. 12, 1932-Feb. 6, 1932. Bottom part of stone remains. " A dear one __ __ ." Faces east.

Green, Mirie, Jan. 2, 1931-Nov. 3, 1931. "My Darling Is At Rest." Faces west.

Lemley, Gordon, Jr., Nov. 21, 1931-Nov. 24, 1931. "Our Darling." Faces west.

Driveway
 No stones north of driveway.

(About 14 ft. with no stone from fence to Lanier stone.)

Lanier, Alton L., Nov. 24, 1907-May 13, 1928. "Gone but not
