 bloom in Heaven." Faces west.

 Mathewson, Mary E., Died Jan. 6, 1921, age 47 yrs. "God's ways
 are just." Faces east.

 Stone broken. Faces east.

 Reavis, Nancy Elizabeth, June 27, 1875-Aug. 22, 1951. "Gone but
 not forgotten." Faces west. Both Reavis graves in fenced in
 family plot. No other stones therein.
 Shasteen, Mary Laster, July 9, 1873-Mar. 10, 1927. Wife of W. D.
 Shasteen. "Gone but not forgotten." Faces west.
 Wynn, Alvin Lavid, Sept. 26, 1925--Jan. 31, 1926.
 "A sunbeam from the world has vanished." Faces west.
 Lanier, Nannie Mae, Mar. 31, 1923-Nov. 20, 1923. "Budded on earth
 to bloom in Heaven." Stone broken. Faces west.
 Smith, Luther E., 1931, "Our darling baby." Faces west.
