Bragg, Bulah, Nov. 16, 1900-Mar. 1, 1925. Faces west. Stone off base, July 1997.

Bragg, Adam F., Oct. 4, 1900-Feb. 13, 1943. "How desolate our home beneft of thee." Faces west.

Bragg, Margrat Mae, Jan. 15, 1922-May 16, 1924. "Asleep in Jesus." Baldwin, Julia, Nov. 16, 1894-May 11, 1924. "Gone but not forgotten". Off base. Faces west. In Yucca plant.

Carden, Sladys Melton, 1908-1927, Daughter of J. A. Carden. "Our loved one." Faces west. Stone in Yucca plant.

Crick, John T., 1891-1923. Faces west.

Driveway

(About 21 ft. with no stones from drive to Bailey stone.)

Bailey, Mollie, Mar. 30, 1889-Aug. 2, 1917, wife of JAB.
"Was borned Mar. 30, 1889. Died Aug. 2, 1917."
Only a few inches show above ground. Marble stone in two

pieces and in the ground.

(About 10 ft. with no stones from Bailey to Baker stone.)

Baker, Woodrow, July 24, 1912-Oct. 29, 1913. "Weep not, he is at rest." Stone in two pieces, off base.

(About 14 ft. with no stones from Baker to Taylor stone.)

Taylor, Laura Estella, May 9, 1898-Dec. 31, 1911. Off base and broken, lays flat.

ROW 32.

(About 24 ft. with no stones from fence to small stck of broken stones.)

The first two stones are badly broken and off their bases. The pieces are stacked on the base for Pritchett child.

Childers, L. R. Aug. 5, 1927-Jan. 4, 1929. Son of Mr. & Mrs. H. H. Childers. "From mother's arms to the arms of Jesus."

Stone broken, on ground.

Pritchett, Joseph A., June 29, 1928-Jan. 9, 1930. Son of Mr. & Mrs. J. A. Pritchett. "Weep not, he is at rest."Stone broken.

Ferrell, W. M. S., Aug. 15, 1873-Dec. 9, 1927. Lower part of stone missing. Lays flat on ground.

Ferrell, Martha Elizabeth, wife of W. M. Ferrell, 1872-1923.

"Gone but not forgotten." Stone broken. Lays flat. Base north of W. M. S. Ferrell's stone.

Franklin, Ida Jane, Dec. 9, 1871-Jan. 30, 1925. Flat stone on ground. Faces east.

Franklin, W. E., Oct. 27, 1868-Mar. 26, 1923. Woodman of the World stone. Faces east.

Driveway. No stones north of driveway.

Hargrove, Opal Virginia, Sept. 27, 1930-Jan. 23, 1931. "In aftertime well meet her." Faces west.

Staggs, Carl William, Apr. 1, 1928-June 13, 1929. Son of Mr. & Mrs. Marvin Staggs. "Darling we miss thee." Faces west. Stone off base.

Young, Helen Louise, July 27, 1929-Sept. 11, 1930. "Our baby" over name, "Only sleeping" under dates. Faces west.
