McBride, Dorothy, May 20, 1929-Aug. 6, 1931, dau. of Mr. & Mrs.
R. D. McBride. "Of such is the kingdom of Heaven." Faces
west.
(About 15 ft with no stones from McBride to Newby plot.)
The next four stones are in Newby plot, marked with four cement
posts with "N" on top of each post.
Newby, Thomas B., April 12, 1865-April 8, 1928. "At rest."
"Father" on footstone. Faces west.
Earls, Dora, Aug. 15, 1891-Dec. 13, 1930. "My love goes with you
and my soul awaits to join you." Stone off base, lays
on ground.
Earls or Earl, James, 1934-1935, cement marker. Lays on ground.
