Moyers, Ida B., 1902-1922. Stone lays flat.

Langley, George Clifton, Apr. 29, 1945-May 7, 1946. Lays flat.

Read from east.

Musgrove, C. J., July, 1880-July 28-1922. "Farewell my wife and children from you a father Christ doth call." Faces east.

The Meltons are buried in the Campbell family plot along with Catherine Campbell on row 41. Marked by cement posts.

Melton, Sallie B., Sept. 13, 1876-Mar. 23, 1953. Double stone with Okley Melton. "Resting in hope of a glorious resurrection.

Melton, Okley, Dec. 1, 1875-June 5, 1948. Faces west.

Melton, John, Jr., Jan. 4, 1929-Aug. 29, 1941. "Our darling." Faces west.

(About 12 ft. with no stone from Melton and Hardy stone.)

Hardy, William D., Nov. 18, 1874-Nov. 22, 1942. "He is not dead but sleepeth." Faces west.

(About 18 ft. with no stones from Hardy to drive.)

Ellett, 1831-1915. Handwritten. Faces west. Far north near fence. ROW 42.

Yell, Milton Lee, Feb. 18, 1902-Mar. 6, 1923. "Gone but not forgotten." Broken in several pieces. Faces west.

Yell, Mrs. Becky, June 22, 1875-Mar. 26, 1928. "No one knew thee but to love thee."

(About 13 ft. with no stones from Yell to Johnson stone.)

Johnson, Lillie Ann, 1947-1947. "Our darling baby." Faces west.

Blank stone.

Taylor, Delia, Feb. 25, 1885-Apr. 18, 1922. "Our mother."

Taylor, Delta, cement marker, no dates. Missing, 1997.

Vess, Oscar, June 26, 1925-Jan. 16, 1926. "Our Darling" above his name, "Gone but not forgotten" below the dates. Broken.

Lays on ground.

Flat stone, lays flat, reads from east.

Lewter, Arthur C., Jr., Dec. 31, 1927-Apr. 10, 1954, flat stone.

Reads from west.

Russell, Maggie H., Sept. 4, 1894-June 12, 1953. Faces east.

"A tender mother and a faithful friend."

Russell, Simon Fate, Apr. 11, 1893-May 22, 1956. Faces east.

"Earth has no sorrow that heaven cannot heal."

These two are in a family plot enclosed with cement border.

Winkles in family plot bounded by cement bars on ground.

Winkles, James G., Oct. 18, 1906-Feb. 5, 1949. Faces east.

"Our loved one" above the name. "Resting in hope of a glorious resurrection" below dates. Faces east.

Winkles, Virgie Mae, 1897-1953. Double stone with Marvin Winkles.

Winkles, Marvin M., 1881-19\_\_\_. Dates not completed. Faces east.

Burkes, Nezzie Ann, June 10, 1897-Apr. 28, 1949. Missing, 1997.
