ELDRIDGE, JOHN M. - Born June 10, 1810 - died Mar. 19, 1901. At rest.

ELDRIDGE, FRANCIS M. - Wife of John M. Eldridge. Born Oct. 14, 1808 - died July 23, 1887. Love is the fulfilling of the law. (Morriss Bro's., Memphis).

ELDRIDGE, POWELL - Born May 27, 1853 - died June 13, 1853.

HAMILTON, NANIE - Nanie, dau. of Rev. G. W. & M. V. Hamilton. Born Aug. 13, 1883 - died Nov. 11, 1884.
