Another fieldstone was marked: "E.B.....1st....Born.....1900.." This may mark the grave of a Bridges or a Buffaloe.

DURHAM - Note: At the north end of this row of graves is a single, large headstone on which is listed the Durham family names and dates. The graves are designated by small stones with initials carved thereon.
