---- Next to Synthia Jane Lane was the grave of a baby marked with an unlettered fieldstone. At the foot of Synthia Jane Lane's grave were three graves marked with unlettered fieldstones.

---- Next to Samuel Lee Newby were the graves of two adults; graves marked with unlettered cement.

MILLER - Fanny Sisk Miller - Born 1870 - Died Aug. 18, 1907

RAWLS - Josie R. Cambron, wife of L. O. Rawls - July 27, 1880 - Nov. 26, 1911

RAWLS - Jennie Editha Rawls - Dec. 20, 1910 - Mar. 15, 1911

CAMBRON - Audrey A. Cambron - Feb. 24, 1885 - Dec. 23, 1913 [Note: On the top of this stone was carved "U.D.C." and on the base was "A Christian 14 yrs. Sec. F.A.C.U. of A. Asleep in Jesus."]

CAMBRON - Sarah J. Walker wife of J. A. Cambron - Feb. 23, 1842 - May 19, 1929

CAMBRON - John A. Cambron - Jan. 23, 1843 - Aug. 5, 1912, married S. J. Walker Dec. 18, 1870.
 [Note: On the base was carved: "Pres. F.A.C.U. of A. 6 yrs. P.M. 1886 - 1906 Depot Agt. 1888 - 1906 J.P. 25 yrs." On top of stone was carved: "C.S.A." and a C.S.A. iron cross, No. 338, was on the grave.]

SHARP - Annie R. Fanning Sharp - May 28, 1890 - Feb. 22, 1921
