STEWART - Thomas Stewart - Died Sept. 29th 1847 in his 76th year

STEWART - Lina Ann, Wife of William Stewart - Born Dec. 25th 1810 - Died Sept. 16th 1841

STEWART - Ann Baylor Stewart - Born June 30, 1815 - Died March 1, 1883

STEWART - William Stewart - Born March 30, 1803 - Died Nov. 6, 1887
