
## **GURLEY CEMETERY**

Location: Section 12-4-2E, SW quarter In the town of Gurley, Alabama. This cemetery covers about 15 acres. Copied in October, 1979.

Note: The diagram is not to scale. It was drawn only to aid people in locating the burial place of their ancestors since the cemetery is so large. It covered approximately 15 acres at the time it was copied.

**Duncan.** James T. Duncan. 1881 – 1934.

**Duncan.** William T. Duncan – 1885-1929, [and] his wife, Sallie True [Duncan], 1858-1948.

Davis. Clara M. Davis - Nov. 17, 1902 - Apr. 21, 1972

Sanders. Edna Emert, wife of James Sanders, Sept. 22, 1909 – Aug. 24, 1930

**Riddle.** James Thomas Riddle – 1883 – 1886. [Next to James was an unlettered fieldstone marking a grave.]

**Baugher.** Claude W. Baugher, Jr. – Dec. 10, 1926 – Aug. 23, 1928

**Baugher.** Myrtle R. Baugher – May 25, 1895 – Dec. 4, 1977 [Note: A funeral marker at the foot of her grave stated: Sarah Myrtle Baugher, 1895-1977 Age 82.] Note: Myrtle R. and Claude W. Baugher shared a stone.

**Baugher.** Claude W. Baugher – Oct. 4, 1892 – Aug. 27, 1962. Military Footstone: Claude Wilson Baugher, Ala. MECH, Batry C, 36 Arty, CAC, World War I (dates repeated.)

**Summers.** Joe Allen Summers – Oct. 12, 1930 – Mar. 4, 1979.

**Cam Summers** – Aug. 10, 1892 – July 24, 1957. *Note: This was a "double stone" but there was no inscription on the other half of the tombstone.* 

Lusk. Anna Catherine Lusk – 1930 - 1931
