**Nance** Homer H. Nance. Nov. 24, 1888 – July 29, 1966.

**Nance.** Lucille G. Nance. Dec. 27, 1888 – Mar. 24, 1953.

**Given.** Walter A. Given. 1866 – 1932. (Masonic emblem on stone.) [Source: Probate file No. 8163. A Petition to Probate, shows his LW&T dated “April & May 1931,” and his death date 10 Feb. 1932.]

**Given.** Annie True Given. 1865 – 1931. [Source: Probate File No. 8163. The Last Will & Testament of Walter A. Given, dated “April & May 1931”, states: “My dear wife, Annie True Given, being afflicted with a disease for which there is no cure [will be] only here for a short time to suffer and die . . . we have been living together for almost 44 years and I have provided for her the best I could under the circumstances . . .”]

**Walker.** Mattie S. Walker. Born 1867 – Died 1901, and Infant son born Feb. 15, 1900. [Note: “Lawler” was written on back of this stone.]
