### **WORLEY CEMETERY**

Location: Section 10-5-2E. E/2 NE NE SE SE. On west wide of road of old New Hope-Gurley Pike (now called James Mann Pike). The *Huntsville Times* state the cemetery is located on Cave Springs Road.

When I visited this grave the stone had fallen and was lying on its back between two cedar trees. It was surrounded by a cotton field. The *Huntsville Times* published a beautiful photograph of this tombstone November 28, 1976 when it was upright.
