Collier. Tavie H. Collier. Oct. 13, 1883. June 9, 1934. Married Dec. 18, 1912 [*Shares stone with Bill I.*]

Collier. Bill I. Collier. Dec. 19, 1873. Dec. 28, 1934. Forever in our hearts.

Herrin. Tolettie Ellinor Herrin. Mother. Tolettie Ellinor, wife of A. D. Herrin. Nove. 19, 1857. Dec. 15, 1934. She was the sunshine of our home.

Herrin. A. D. Herrin., husband of T. E. Herrin. May 25, 1851. Feb. 17 [**19?**] 1927. None knew thee but to love thee.

Herrin. Pearl Herrin. November 14, 1890. Dec. 16, 1955.

In un-kept part of cemetery.

Norment. To my Darling. C. Henry Norment. Born Jan. 17, 1887. Died July 29, 1901. Asleep in Jesus.

Norment. John Francis Norment. *This is a fieldstone with J. F. N. carved on it.*

Martin. Kenneth W. Martin. Dec. 10, 1948. Dec. 10, 1948. Gone so soon.

Martin. Jattie B. Martin. Died Nov. 25, 1935 1836 aged 60 years [funeral marker.]

Pruitt. Elizabeth Ann Pruitt Died April 14, 1954 aged 12 yrs. [funeral marker.]

Mrs. **Ener** [illegible] Died Aug. 17, 1946 aged 39 yrs. [funeral marker]

Mance. Sallie O. Mance. March 5, 1905 – Sept. 9, 1931

Historical Note The *Huntsville Times* of June 7, 2007 carried an article about this cemetery being added to the State's "Alabama Historic Cemetery Register, it being the third in Madison County added to the list and 103rd in the state.
