### **George F. Bulman**

Died Aug. 27, 1863  
*[No other info. on stone.]*

*The 1850 census shows a Bulman family living in this area. Henry J. Bulman m. Emily Honea, Lic. Nov. 10, 1848:*

*[Mai Taylor m. Nancy McCartney Aug. 26, 1828 in Madison Co., Al.]*

1850 Census of Mai Taylor family shows him as a farmer with property valued at \$1000.

### **Walter H. Berry**

### **Richard H. Bently**

Born Jan. 1, 1908  
Died Feb. 20, 1908

### **G. W. Bentley**

Born May 14, 1850  
Died Dec. 28, 1921

### **Sarah M. Bently**

Wife of G. W. Bentley  
Died March 10, 1906  
*[No other information]*

*Note: There was an extra "e" on the last name of Richard*

*and G. W. (Bentley) but was "Bently" on Sarah M's stone.*

### **C. M. Rousseau**

Oct. 22, 1871  
Oct. 19, 1935

### **Adeline E. Rosseau**

Wife of C. M. Rosseau  
Nov. 6, 1871  
Feb. 22, 1920

*Note difference in spelling on C. M.'s and Adeline's tombstones.*

### **F. T. Butler**

Born May 26<sup>th</sup> 1847  
Died April 16<sup>th</sup> 1907  
*Shares stone with Adeline*  
**Adeline H. Butler**  
Wife of F. T. Butler  
Born Sept. 17, 1850  
Died Feb. 11, 1908  
*[Enclosed by a fence.]*  
*Francis T. Butler m. Adaline H. Maples 13 Oct. 1865.*

### **James E. Butler**

1843 – 1913  
Father  
*Note: There was a large CSA iron cross on this grave. Not numbered.*  
*James E. Shares stone with Nancy J.*

### **Nancy J. Butler**

his wife.  
1849 – 1939  
Mother.

### **Jas. Canada Butler**

1870 – 1925  
Brother  
*[Note the three above stones of Jas. E., Nancy and Jas. Canada were in a fenced area.]*

### **J. T. Hodges**
