Containing two hundred & forty acres more or less, to have and to hold the above described tracts or parcels of land, with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Thomas C. Barclay his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever, And the said Cha^s W. Strong and Mattison O. H. Strong will warrant and forever defend the title to the hereby granted premises to the party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, and from and against themselves their heirs Executors administrators and assigns, and from and against the lawful claims and title of all and every person whomsoever, In Testimony whereof the said party of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seals, this the day and date above written
