of my Estate both real and personal, be equally divided among all my living children
(or the living heirs of their body) - The three above named Daughters, Francis, Susan

notwithstanding the above mentioned special Legacies - Provided however that the
portion falling to my Daughter Mary Ann be subject to the same requirements
that are made in reference to the boy (Gleick) given to her above

The last will and Testament of William Landman was this day produced in
open Court for probate, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that
the widow Janet of this has had reasonable notice of this application, and
makes no objection, whereupon said will is admitted to proof, and the execu-
tion thereof being duly proved by the oaths of William Lanier and Richard
Elliott two of the subscribing witnesses thereof, was ordered to be filed for further
proof - And now subsequently, it being a day of the Term of said Court
As wit, the 23rd day of February 1829

The last Will and Testament of William Landman deceased which
was heretofore produced in open Court for probate, and only proved by the oaths
of William Lanier and Richard Elliott, two of the subscribing witnesses,
thereof, and ordered to be filed for further proof, was again this day produced in
open Court and the execution thereof being duly proved by the oath of James
W. Allen, the other subscribing witness thereof, was ordered to be recorded
and is duly done this 23rd day of June 1829 - Extracted from the Minutes
