son of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, for the use and
purpose herein after mentioned - Witnesseth that the said Batt Jordan for
in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt
being acknowledged here this my bargain and sale shown and engaged me
by these presents as hereinafter set out and unto the said Nett Langford W. Blake
Henry Jordan Liza Jordan Nicholas Hesteroff W. Ellison W. Bitt and Le Thompson
and their executors or assigns forever a certain lot or parcel of
ground lying & being in the County State of Alabama being part of the
land whereon the said Batt Jordan now resides and situated at one corner
more or less and is bounded as follows, to wit: beginning at a rock on the
line of Ellison Jordan running one mile 73 yards by a white oak on point
the meeting corner which is made for right line to a corner rock thence west 67
yards to another corner rock which are made one line to another corner rock
thence north 73 yards to another corner stone beginning by a red oak which was
a side line thence east to the beginning to have had to hold the same number
lot or parcel of land with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining unto the said Nett Langford W. Blake Henry Jordan
Liza Jordan Nicholas Hesteroff W. Ellison W. Bitt and Le Thompson
and their executors or assigns forever in full and they shall sell and trade
or lease to be made and dealt on the said land a house of masonry
except for the use of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church now
