In the Honorable J. S. Commissioner
Seals of Probate of Madison County
Alabama

Your Petitioner William G. Love
and Mary A. E. Love (whose maiden
name was Mary A. E. Rawlins) represent
that on the 15th day of February 1840 when
Eldred Rawlins then said dec'd of
Madison was appointed by the then ter-
minal Court of said County the guardian
of the estate of said Mary she being at
the time an infant under twenty one
years of age and the daughter of
said Eldred Rawlins - that said Eldred
Love upon being of the said office you
bond & qualify as such guardian
as appears of record in your office
and a true copy of his estate

That said Eldred after words removed
from this State and departed this
life intestate, without having previous-
ly made any settlement of his
said guardianship - that in the year
1856 letters of administration upon

Petition of the said infant
and her husband (William G.
Love) to compel the Court
of Probate of Madison County
Alabama, James J. Williams
Guardian of said
Order to be taken and
