 Ordered - that the said Clement G. Lanier be appointed
 Guardian of said Mary A. E. Rawlins by his giving
 Bond and Security - Whereupon the said Clement
G. Lanier presented his Bond as such Guardian for the sum
 of Twenty Thousand Dollars with William R. Dickert and
Elijah R. Ballaw as securities - and it is by the Court
 Ordered - that the same be received and filed - and further
 Ordered - that the same be recorded
 Ordered - that letters of Guardianship Issue to Clement G.
Lanier in and upon the person Goods and Chattels, rights
 and Credits of Mary A. E. Rawlins his Ward -
 Ordered - that said Guardian make a just full and com-
 plete Inventory of all and singular the goods and Chattels
 rights and Credits of his said Ward
 Ordered - that said Guardian make a return of said In-
 ventory to this Court within three Months
