Alva Jacobs died on or about the year 1914 without leaving a last will and testament. There was no administration upon the estate of Alva Jacobs. He left as his sole and only heirs-at-law, his mother, Emily Jacobs, Addie Jacobs, a sister; Ernest Jacobs, a brother; Eera Jacobs, a sister and Booker T. Jacobs, a brother.

After all of the research into Love family association with the land of the arsenal, it leaves the question open as to why the cemetery has been known as the **Jordan Cemetery**. A check of older land records puts some light upon that question, beginning in 1818 with Nancy Auld's purchase (as "devisee" of Isaac Jackson, deceased – who likewise figured in the land dealing associated with the Jones Cemetery, 37-5) from the government of the NW/4 of S5-T5-R1W, where the cemetery is located:
