

Other children in the home headed by this Isaac Jacobs (there was another Isaac Jacobs in the county, a cousin of Ellie's father, born August of 1845 and married to Nancy, who was b. Sept. 1847) were: Frank (b. Nov. 1879), James (b. Dec. 1881), George (b. May 1889), Joseph (b. May 1891), Dock (b. Aug. 1892), Tyra (a son, b. May 1895), and Charity Ann (b. Oct. 1897). The census record shows that Isaac and "Bittie" had been married for 22 years by 1900 , and that Bittie had given birth to 11 children, 8 or 9 of whom were still living when the census was taken. [The numbers 8 and 9 are written over one another with equal weight, so it is impossible to tell which number is correct. If the 9 is correct, then one of the children was not enumerated as a part of the household, probably due to marriage and establishing a house of their own.] The Isaac Jacobs family in 1900 was living between two Simpson families, one of which was headed by William Simpson (age 66) and his wife Cornelia (age 64). The Simpsons had been married for only 35 years, so it is possible that Cornelia was a second wife to
