



Redstone Arsenal: Lipscomb Cemetery, June, 2002.

Harriet N. Lipscomb appeared in only one census record -- 1850 Madison County, AL. She was listed as 6 years old, born in AL, on the census sheet dated November 9, 1850. Head of the Lipscomb household is given at that time as Sarah, age 47, born in VA. Sarah was the wife of Richard Lipscomb (see tombstone photo) and mother of Robert, who is given as age 24 on the census, born in VA. Other children in the home were: Martha A. R. 23 (see tombstone photo), Manerva J. 21, and

John T. 20 -- all listed as born in VA. Children of the Lipscomb household listed as born in AL were: Mary E. 18, Elizabeth V. 16, Theophilus J. 12, Margaret E. 9, Sarah R. 8, and Harriet N. 6.

John T. Lipscomb is buried in the north portion of the old section, Madison City Cemetery. Apparently, the family moved from Virginia to Madison County, AL, in 1830-1, from birthplaces and ages of the children.
