1910 Census of Madison County AL: John E. Jones, age 44, married twice, in current marriage for 3 years.

(This image was very weak or “washed out” on the original census sheet, with very little ink in evidence. It has been darkened and the contrast boosted to enhance the readability of the remaining writing. This particular image is simply a portion of the entire page, giving a “zoom” effect for the areas of interest. The entire page is shown below, as the next image.)

The 1910 census shows John E. Jones with a different wife. The name is mostly unreadable, but it appears to be perhaps Virginia Jane. John is correctly shown as age 44, while his wife is now only 21 years old. The marriage codes in the census record show that it is his 2nd marriage and her first, having been in effect for 3 years.
