record research may provide some clues. It would be expected that the cemetery derived its name from the older Andy Cowan, but that is not yet established.

The 1880 census data inserted below from the Family History Resource disks produced by the Latter Day Saints church may provide some insights into the family of Andy Cowan and his neighbors of the time:
