This indenture made and entered into this the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April 1905 between Riley Toney and his wife Sallie Toney of the County of Madison State of Alabama, parties of the first part and Powhatan Toney, Harris Toney and Samuel Arnett, of the County of Madison State of Alabama, parties of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Riley Toney and his wife Sallie Toney for and in consideration of Fifteen Dollars (\$15<sup>00</sup>) to them in hand paid by the said Powhatan Toney Harris Toney and Samuel Arnett Trustees in Trust, and their successors in office for the Methodist Episcopal Church and known as Spring Hill Church for the use and benefit of the ministry and membership of said Church in the United States of America subject to the discipline usage, and ministerial appointments of the said Church as from time to time authorized and declared, and if sold the proceeds shall be disposed of and used in accordance with the provision of said discipline. the receipt is hereby acknowledged has this day given, granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do give, grant, bargain sell, convey and confirm unto the said above named Trustees
