The North east quarter of Section 11, Township 5 Range 2 West, excepting therefrom approximately eleven (11) acres in the Southwest part thereof, said tract herein claimed as exemption being less in area than 60 acres, and the interest of applicant therein being less in value than Five Thousand (\$5000.00) Dollars.
