payment thereof, we bind ourselves and heirs, jointly and severally.

Witness our hands and seals, this, the 30 day of March 1896.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That the said Powhatan G.
Toney
hath this day prayed a License from the Judge of the Probate Court of Madison County,
to be married to Mary T. Graves.
Now if there be no lawful cause to obstruct such marriage, then the above obligation to be
void; otherwise to remain in full force.
