Because of the close association of the Wall, McLeod and Steger families, an abbreviated Wall genealogy is presented here: In Mrs. Samuel Allen Wilkinson, D.A.R. application papers (National Number 39771). She decends from James Wall, ancestor of the Madison County family, as follows: Her parents were Alexander Heath Simpson, 1841-1919, and Helen Grey (Steger) Simpson, 1843-1898. Helen Grey Steger, was the daughter of Kennon Harris Steger, 1806-1892, and Mary Elizabeth Wall, 1821-1899, his wife. Mary Elizabeth Wall, was the daughter of Alexander Grey Wall, 1793-1836, and Mary Cooper, 1801-1869, his wife, they were married 1820. Alexander Grey Wall was the son of James Wall, 1760-1830, and Mary Turner, 1763-1838.

Orphans Court Minutes Book 67, page 505: WALL, Alexander G. dec'd. Petition to sell land by Alfred Howell, the Admr. Sally C. WALL, Alfred A. WALL, Helen G. WALL and James T. WALL four of the heirs are infants; guardian ad litem is appointed and he and Kennon H. Steger and Wife Mary Elizabeth, formerly WALL, and one of the children of said Alexander G. WALL dee'd are to be cited. 20 Sept. 1839.
