The second page (not shown in this report) of this 1840 census record reports that Theophilus Lacy owned 11 slaves. Moreover, while the occupation of Theophilus was given as “**Farmer**” in the 1850 and 1860 census records, the last census where he appears (in 1870 he is listed as age 65, six years before his death) gives his occupation as “**Cashier in bank**”:
