and Hopkins Lacy - In virtue of the power in us vested by the decree of the said
Court, we do hereby convey to Alfred Howell the following Lots designated and
known in the original plan of said Town by the Numbers 79. 80. 87 and by the
numerical arrangement of subsequent plat, 48. 47. 49. Each Lot containing forty
nine square poles and measuring seven poles on each square - and said three Lots uni-
-ted at one central corner with Lot N^o 88 of the original plat by the numerical ar-
-rangement of the subsequent Lot N^o 50. reference being had to said plats the
same will ^{more} fully appear - Said Lots being situate on the South end of said Town.
