

Other than the land transactions and census records of 1830 and 1840, very little is known of Alfred Howell and his family from local data. What is known from the census data is that in 1830 his family was recorded as being comprised of one male age $30-40$ (Alfred himself), two females age $0-5$, one female age $10-15$, and one female age $30-40$ (Alfred's wife Sarah G. Howell). They lived in Township 5 in 1830, which only indicates that they were in the general area around the cemetery, but definitely living in the southern portion of the county.

The 1840 census shows the Howell family still in the southern portion of the county, but a list of their neighbors on the census page indicates that they
