The marriage of George Darwin to Lilly Belle <u>Jamar</u> indicates that the land was in fact still remaining in the Jamar family after 1912. Furthermore, a check of the census records shows that George was a son of Sydney S. Darwin, whose wife was **Mary Dickson** <u>Lanier</u>. Thereby, it is seen that the land was still in the hands of several prominent pioneer families, tied together in George Darwin and his wife.
