In this and therefore your petitioners
 for your honor as you a decree and
 order to sell said slaves for the purpose
 of a division between the same thing
 is tenable in Common - they pray also

 as the administrator of John S. Fitch
 dec'd and David C. Humphreys as the
 administrators of John Johnson
 dec'd, Sophia Fitch, Anna Smith
