

Madison County Deed Book KK, pages 627 – 628, records the sale in 1869 by William Timmons of land to William Joiner, Elisha Joiner, and James Timmons -- all of whom were former slaves who had probably worked the same 55 acres that he sold to them for \$637.98 (\$11.60 per acre).

first part, for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred
and thirty seven $\frac{98}{100}$ Dollars to them in hand paid, the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have this day
bargained and sold, and by these presents, doth, bargain,
sell, enfeoff and convey unto the aforesaid William Joiner
Elisha Joiner and James Timmons, their heirs and assigns
forever, all that certain tract or parcel of Land, known
and designated as follows; The fractional part of the North
East Quarter of section No. 21, and the fractional part of
the North west Quarter of section No 22, in Township
no. 5, of Range No. 1, west of the Basis Meridian, and, de-
scribed as follows (viz) Beginning at a Stake sixteen (16) Chins
