I have and to hold the above described Tractif Soil with the tenements and appoint in ances Therewants belonging or in any . wie appertaining unto the said Abralow Lorney his hein and apyor forever: And the said John M. Looney & Nancy his wife for themselve thus hars executors and administrators, dothe warrant and will forered defend the tills to the above described and hereby granted premites with the Said Abs about borney his hein and afigns from and against hund the de John the Dooney his hein & Administraton, and all and every funder the - Sons claiming or holding under hims the said John M. Lorney and Mar ey her wife, and ales a gainet the law ful title claim or domand of allow wery persons or pressons whomsoever claiming or holding, by from or und The Lorney of the United States In lestimony whereof the last Solar M Lorney & Nancy his wife have hereun to set their hand a year above written to the foreigned of adversed of the foreigned of adversed of the second John M. Note that the above deed specified the "West half of the North <u>West</u> Quarter" of Section 35, T4S-R2W. That was a recording error, as John W. Looney never owned that parcel of land to sell to anyone. He had bought the west half of the north<u>east</u> quarter of Section 35 from the government in 1818, per Certificate Number 781. The loss of the (properly specified) land from the family's possession is recorded below, in the sheriff's account of the sale. Absalom had paid \$800 to John W. Looney on May 7 of 1829 for the land. On October 5 of the same year, it sold at auction for only \$230 to settle a debt of \$189.42.
