## Oakland United Methodist Church and School\*

According to a State Historical Commission marker in front of it, Oakland United Methodist Church has its beginnings before the Civil

War. In late 1879, the church members bought land and put up a one-room frame building. Worship services and classes for children of color were held here. In 1929, the county board of education took over the school and continued its oversight until it was closed in 1952. The original church building was destroyed by a tornado in the 1970s. The present-day church is modern and was renovated in the 1990s.
