May 26, 1821

Married in this place Tuesday evening last by REV. LUCAS KENNEDY, REV. JAMES L. SLOSS, Rector of Selma Academy to Mrs. LETITIA TROWBRIDGE of this place. Note: LETITIA was nee CAMPBELL dau. of ELIZABETH See LETITIA's marriage to HENRY TROWBRIDGE Apr. 1819 in our Vol 56; and our Vol. 208 p. 11.

June 2, 1821

Married in this county on Sunday evening last, Mr. WILLIAM FOSTER, merchant of this place to Miss S(ABRINA) ROBERTS. Ancestor of Mrs. Bettina Higdon, whose address in 1977 was Cullman, Alabama.

June 23, 1821

Married on Tuesday evening by REV. J. L. SLOSS, WILLIAM TROTTER, Esq. a senator from Washington County, to Mrs. PENELOPE VANDYKE of this town.

June 30, 1821

Married in Cahawba by REV. JAMES LONG SLOSS on Thursday evening last, DR. THOMAS LESLY to Miss PELITIA M LANE, daughter of EDMUND LANE, Esq. all of this place. (See our Vol. 77 p. 36)

Married last evening by J. B. THORINGTON, Esq. CAPT. WILLIAM BOSWELL to Miss ELIZA LEE, daughter of CAPT. WILLIAM LEE of this county.
