Ala. 1/36 where that that MASTIN WOODALL (shown on most records as MARTIN WOODALL) is the father. MASTIN lived in Johnston Co. N.C. was m. there ca 1795 (Marriage rec. not dated) to JUDITH GILES. He rec'd land grants around 1800 & bo't several tracts. He sold all of his land at different times, the last being in 1815. DAVID named his 1st son JOSEPH MASTIN WOODALL. This from a Family Bible. MASTIN had a son in right age bracket to be DAVID. Was MASTIN ever in Ala?"
