December 14, 1842

Married on Thursday evening, December 1st by REV. MR. HAMILTON of Tuscaloosa, the HON. WALTER R(ALEIGH) ROSS, Senator from Wilcox County to the amiable and much admired MRS. ANN BOZMAN of Greene County.

Note: He was a pensioner of War of 1812.

December 28, 1842

Died on the 10th of December last in Pickens County, OBADIAH STRICKLAND, SENR. aged 79 years and 11 months, formerly of Franklin County, North Carolina. Member of the Baptist Church for 30 years.
